Jury Awards \$9.3 Million for Foot Crushed By Sanitation Truck

During a routine collection, Sanitationman, Joseph Spoto, sustained a catastrophic foot injury after a departmental truck rolled over his foot, requiring ten operations. The City had prior knowledge that this truck had mechanical problems. As a result, a jury awarded our client \$9,323,652 for pain and suffering and lost pay.

Fall Through Floor, Jury Awards \$3.8 Million

Sanitationman, Louis Caiazzo, fell through a rotted floor injuring his knee, lower back and groin, which required surgery. Because the City of New York had received prior written notice of the rotted floor, a jury awarded \$3,850,000 for pain and suffering and lost pay.

Fall Down Staircase Settled for \$500,000


Sanitationman, John O'Day, was injured when he fell descending a staircase at Fresh Kills Land Fill. He suffered lower back injuries, requiring surgery and forcing early retirement. This case was successfully settled for \$500,000.

Slip and Fall Due to Leaking Oil, Settled for \$350,000

Sanitationman, Daniel Guglielmo, slipped and fell at Fresh Kills Land Fill on grease from a crane. As a result, he suffered a fractured wrist, which required surgery. We successfully settled his case before trial for \$350,000.

Trip and Fall in Sanitation Parking Lot, Settled for \$160,000

While walking in a parking lot, a Sanitationman tripped and fell injuring his right knee. He underwent arthoscopic surgery and retired early. This case was successfully settled for \$160,000.
